# **Presidents Report**

The end of the 2023 season at the YKGC was a continuation of an unusual season. With favorable weather we were able to keep the course open a week longer than we have in the past, this came with a few challenges as our grounds worker ended up getting a new job before he was able to complete the closing. Thankfully some of our members volunteered some time and completed the snow fences and the rest of the closing items.

There have been two instances where someone has cut locks of some of the private cart sheds and syphoned gas out of the carts, there was no other thefts or damages just the gas. A few members have increased the presence around the area while walking their dogs and will continue to do so until the depth of snow limits easy access.

The new four-year lease agreement for 30 new rental carts has been completed with a spring 2024 delivery date, these 30 new carts added to the 10 we received in 2023 (backordered from 2022) will give us a new fleet of 40 rental carts. With a more comprehensive preventive maintenance program in place these carts should have better longevity and hopefully we will not have the battery issues that we had with the current fleet in the last year of their lease.

The 2024 season should be a busy and exciting season with unfinished or not started work that was planned in 2023 as well as new projects proposed for the 2024 season.
