



Irrigation Levy

One of the main focuses of the Yellowknife Golf Club Board of Directors is to improve the golf experience while keeping the costs for play as low as possible.

We had a long term goal of completing our irrigation system to water the grass aprons on the holes over a number of years to spread the costs. At the end of the 2015 season we had to accelerate the irrigation system plan when the water truck reached the end of its life. This resulted in us completing the irrigation system much faster than planned.

<i>2" HDPP Pipe</i>	<i>\$35,000</i>
<i>6" HDPP Pipe & Installation</i>	<i>\$14,500</i>
<i>Manifold</i>	<i>\$1,500</i>
<i>Water Pump</i>	<i>\$10,000</i>
<i>Shed for Pump</i>	<i>\$3,000</i>

Total = \$64,000 (not including Club Maintenance Staff labour or Bobcat rental)

In order to keep our memberships and green fees at the same rate we have added an irrigation levy to recover the capital expenditure spent on the irrigation system and allow us to move forward with other capital projects on the golf course.

The irrigation levy will work as follows:

Memberships (one time levy paid at time of purchase):

- Adult Members \$50.00
- Senior Members \$25.00
- Junior Members \$25.00
- Student Members \$25.00

Green Fees:

- 9 Holes \$0.50
- 18 Holes \$1.00
